



Apprenticeship Applications

The IUOE LOCAL 571 TRAINING FUND will be Accepting Applications for the Operating Engineers Apprenticeship Program. All applicants must be able to proficiently understand, speak, and write in English language.

Minimum qualifications and documents you must bring are:

- 18 years of age
- Valid driver's license and have a current DMV report
- Certified copy of birth certificate
- Social security card
- High school diploma (GED)
- Physically capable of performing the duties of an Operating Engineer
- Able to pass a drug screen (DOT)
- Applicants need to include a \$25 non-refundable administrative fee, payable with a MONEY ORDER ONLY, to the **International Union of Operating Engineers Local 571 Training Fund**. Cash or personal checks will NOT be accepted.

You must apply in person.

The time frame to bring the minimum qualification documents, read our Standards of Apprenticeship, and fill out an application is from Mid-November – Mid-December.

The site is closed Thanksgiving weekend.
